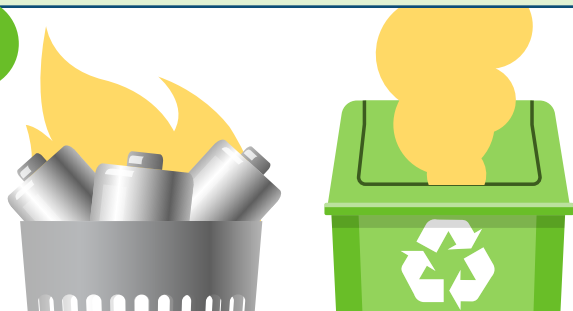


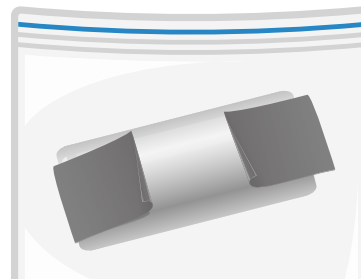

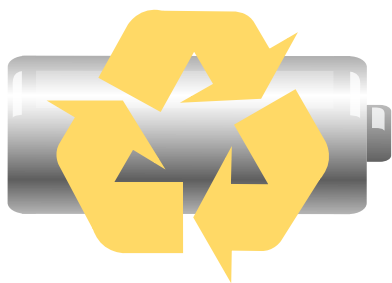
Never place batteries in regular waste and recycling bins. **They will likely catch fire.**

To prevent fires, **tape battery terminals** and/or **place lithium-ion batteries in a separate bag**. Keep batteries segregated from other materials.
