

WORKPLACE ELECTRICAL FATALITIES 2011 - 2024


Every year, the Electrical Safety Foundation International (ESFI) compiles **workplace safety data** from the **Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS)** and the **Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA)** to track trends on **electrical safety in the workplace**.

WORKPLACE SAFETY TRENDS

1,654 electrical fatalities in the workplace between 2011 - 2024

70% of all workplace electrical fatalities are in **non-electrical occupations**


Electrical fatality rates have stayed steady between 2011-2024



WORKPLACE ELECTRICAL FATALITIES BY INDUSTRIES


6 industries experienced **44%** of workplace electrical fatalities

WORKPLACE ELECTRICAL FATALITIES BY OCCUPATIONS


5 Occupations accounted for almost **50%** of all workplace electrical fatalities
